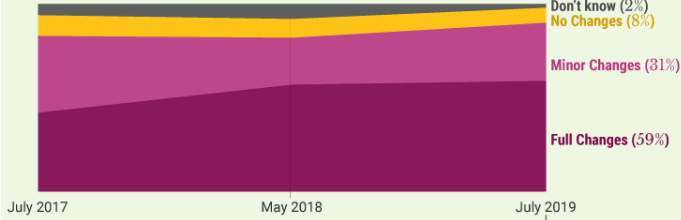

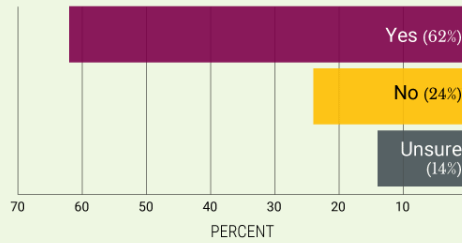

Do you think changes are needed in Russia?



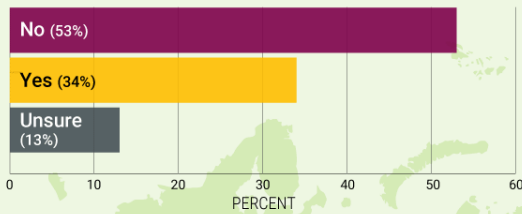
Do you think there is an economic crisis in Russia?



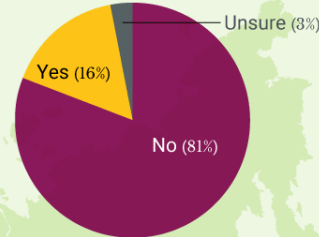
The percentage of people in favor of decisive changes in Russia has increased 12 percent in the past two years.

48 percent of urban-dwelling Russians say they will never live to see a decent salary.

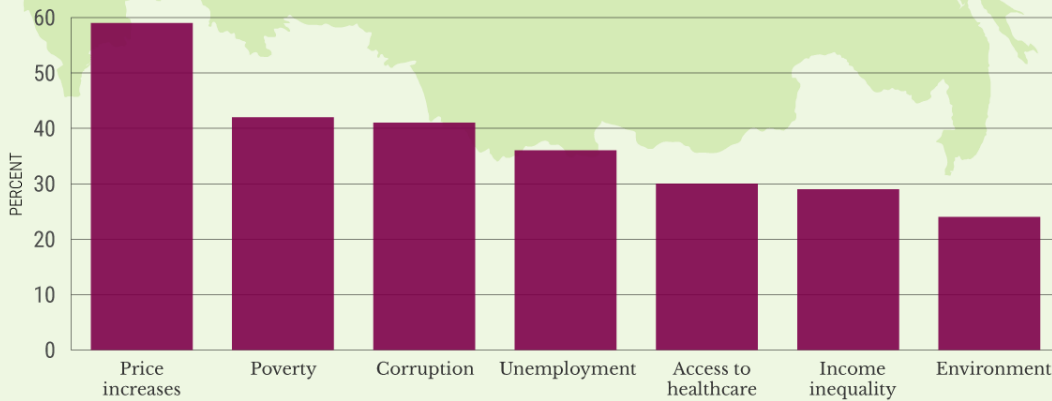
Are changes possible in the existing political system?



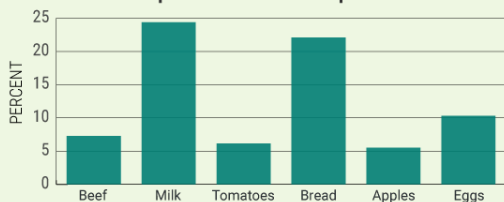
Do you feel you have opportunities to improve your living conditions?



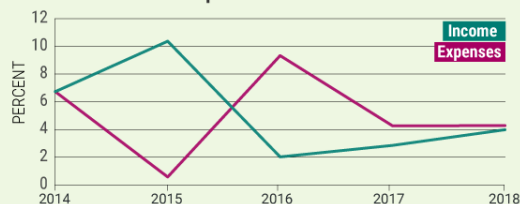
Which problems are most acute in Russia?
